The 2010 Envision Twilight Concert Series is dedicated to Norma Kenney. Norma's tireless drive and determination as founding president of the Mission Heritage Association saw Fraser River Heritage Park founded in 1985 as a centre of culture and heritage for the community of Mission.

FRASER RIVER HERITAGE PARK'S 25TH YEAR

Fraser River Heritage Park and the Mission Heritage Association

In 1980, a group of local volunteers led by Norma Kenney incorporated the Mission Heritage Association (MHA) with a mandate to preserve heritage sites, artifacts, and buildings found in the Mission area, and a vision of creating a world-class heritage park.

When the BC government decided in 1983 to use the former St Mary's Mission lands for a high-density housing development, the MHA quickly interceded and persuaded the government to designate the land as a park. The MHA's unceasing efforts to preserve and maintain Mission's rich cultural heritage culminated in the establishment of the stunning Fraser River Heritage Park.

The MHA began developing the park in 1985, and has since managed, maintained, and improved it with the cooperation first of the Regional District, and more recently the District of Mission. The MHA has, with overwhelming support from the community, built all the structures you see in the park, including the Norma Kenney House; established rose, rhododendron, and memorial gardens; rebuilt the Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes; erected the covered picnic area and bell tower; initiated and continued to present the annual free Twilight Concert Series and other beloved events, including Mission's Canada Day celebrations and Santa in the Park; hosted events ranging from the Folk Festival to Old Car Sunday to the Lady of Lourdes Pilgrimage; successfully registered the park as a heritage landscape; and begun work on a heritage walk and perimeter trail.

The MHA continues to expand Mission's flagship park as a centre of community activity and local cultural history, and Fraser River Heritage Park remains close to the hearts of Mission residents as a great park that belongs to all of us.
